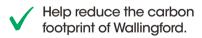
## About us

Sustainable Wallingford is a community group of people living locally and working together to help build a greener future for Wallingford and the wider area.

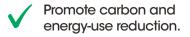
We organise events and projects on issues including energy, waste, transport, food, and biodiversity, following the guiding principles of the UK Sustainable Development Strategy to be:
